

## Cost of Attendance Budget

### 2015/2016 Cost of Attendance Budget

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an estimate of the average cost a student would incur as a result of attending college. The amounts used in the cost of attendance are not anticipated to cover all of the student's living expenses. Individual cost may differ from the colleges COA.

Using the student's expected family contribution and the average COA, the college financial aid will award student's need and non-need based aid.

Below are the estimated costs for the 2015/2016 Award Year based on a Fall and Spring semester:
